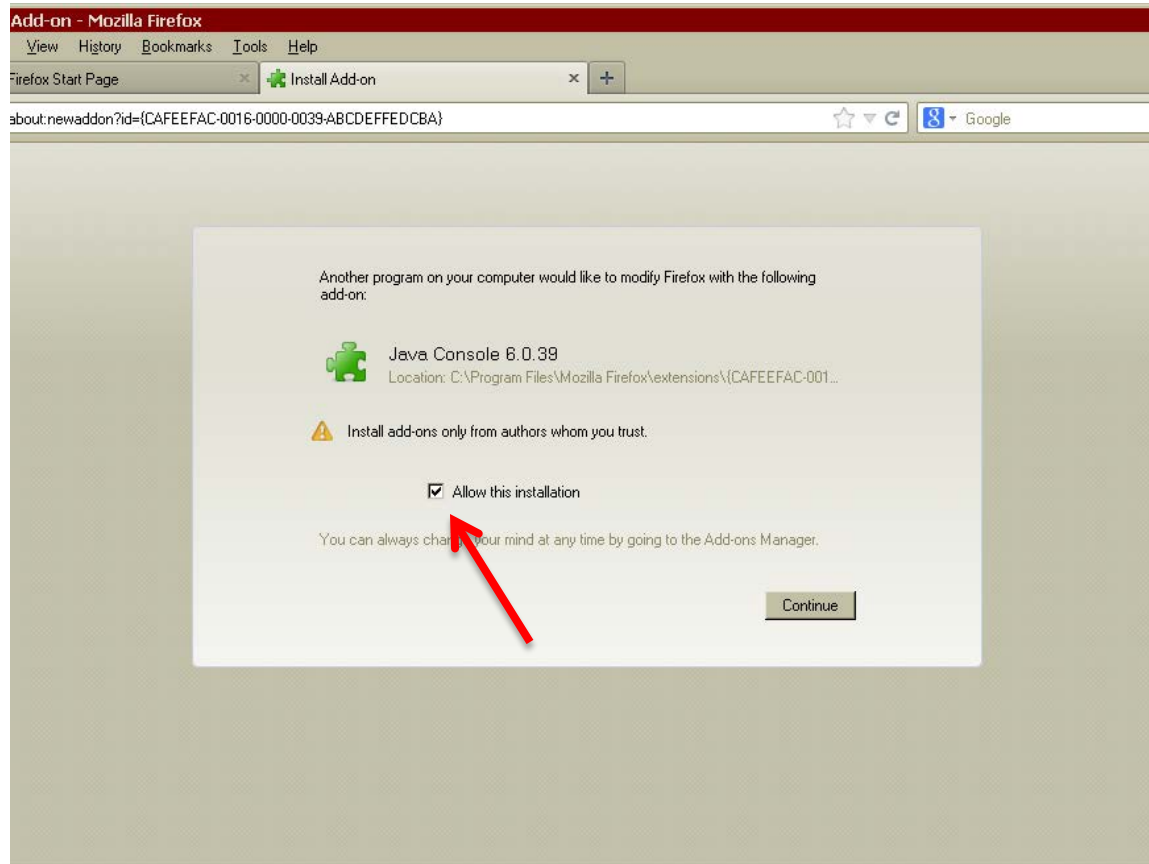
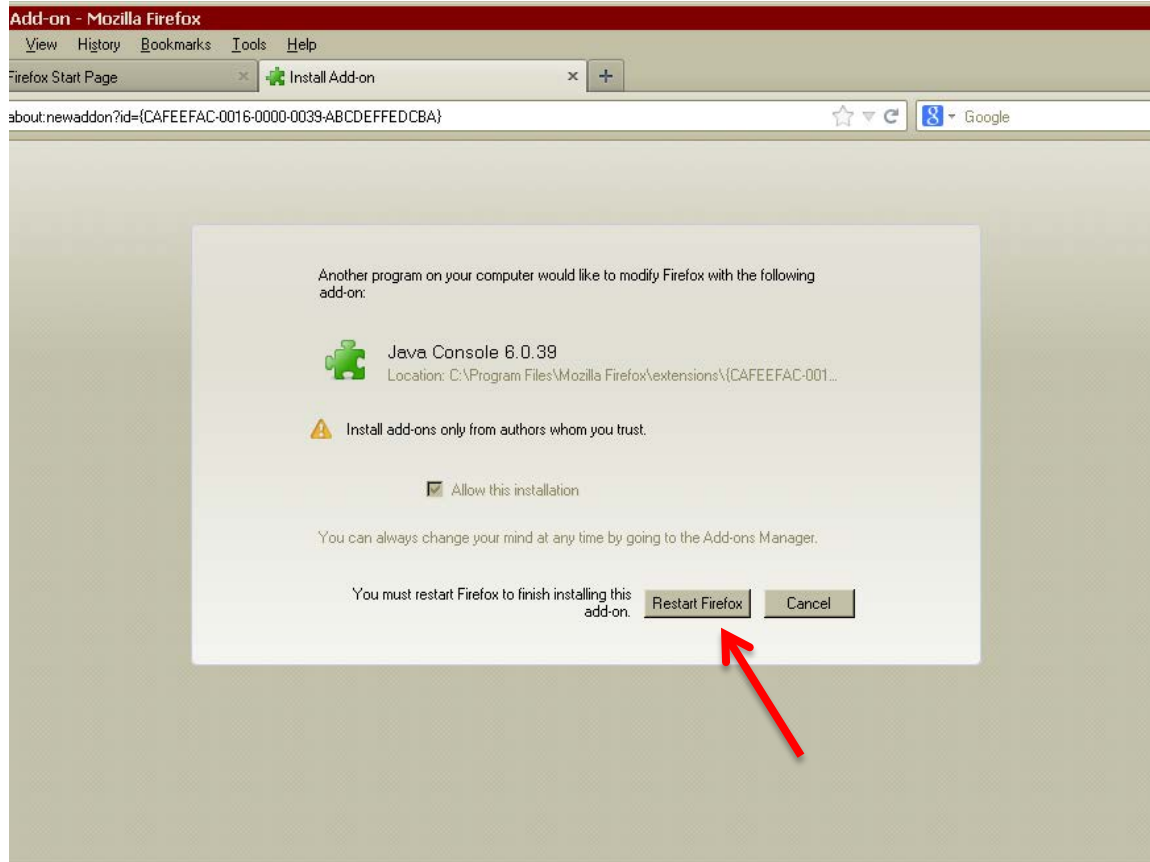


- You may need to perform the following steps if your Java applet (e.g. WebMO) does not appear correctly in your browser
- Every time Firefox or Java is automatically or manually updated, the Java add-on may need to be confirmed safe
- Reminder: In order to keep your computer safe, only download from trusted sources. Download Java runtime from ***www.java.com***



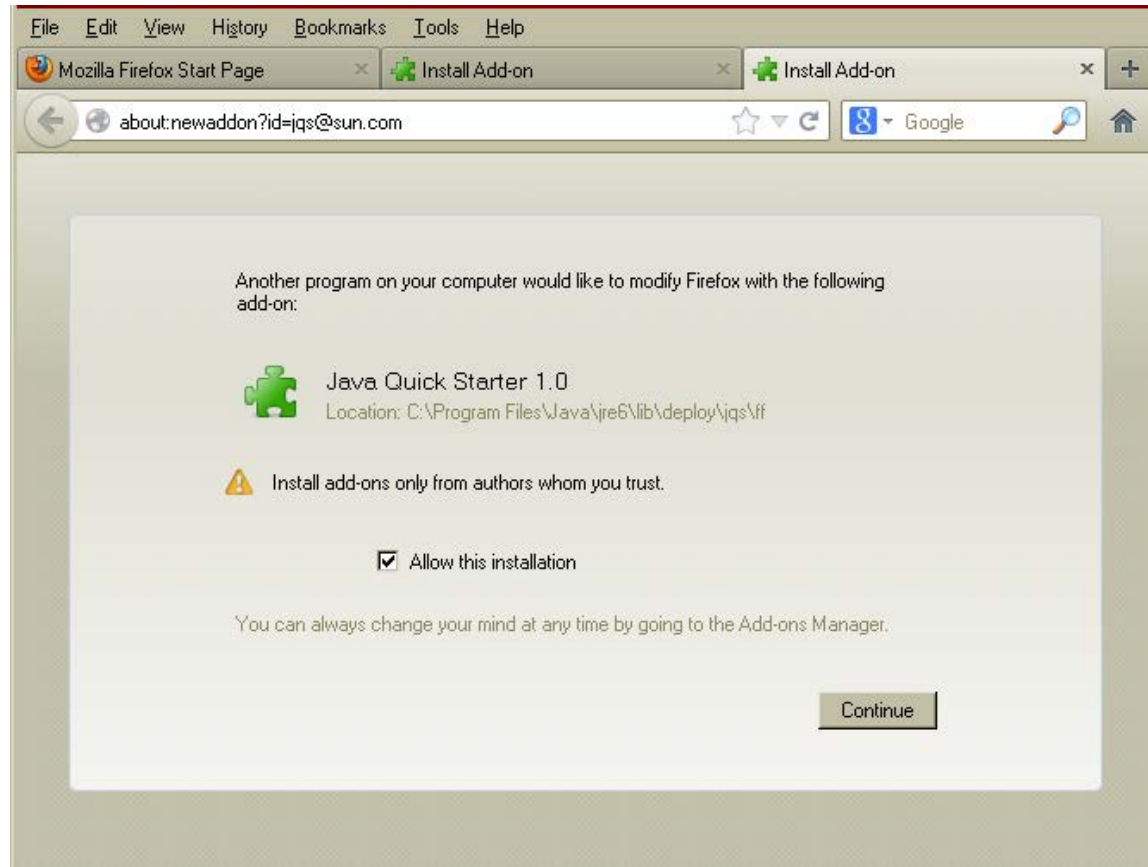
## Allow Java Console Installation

After the installation of Java runtime, this warning window will show up when you first open the Firefox browser. Check the ***Allow this installation*** checkbox and the ***Continue*** button to continue (Your Java version number may be different).



## Restarting Firefox

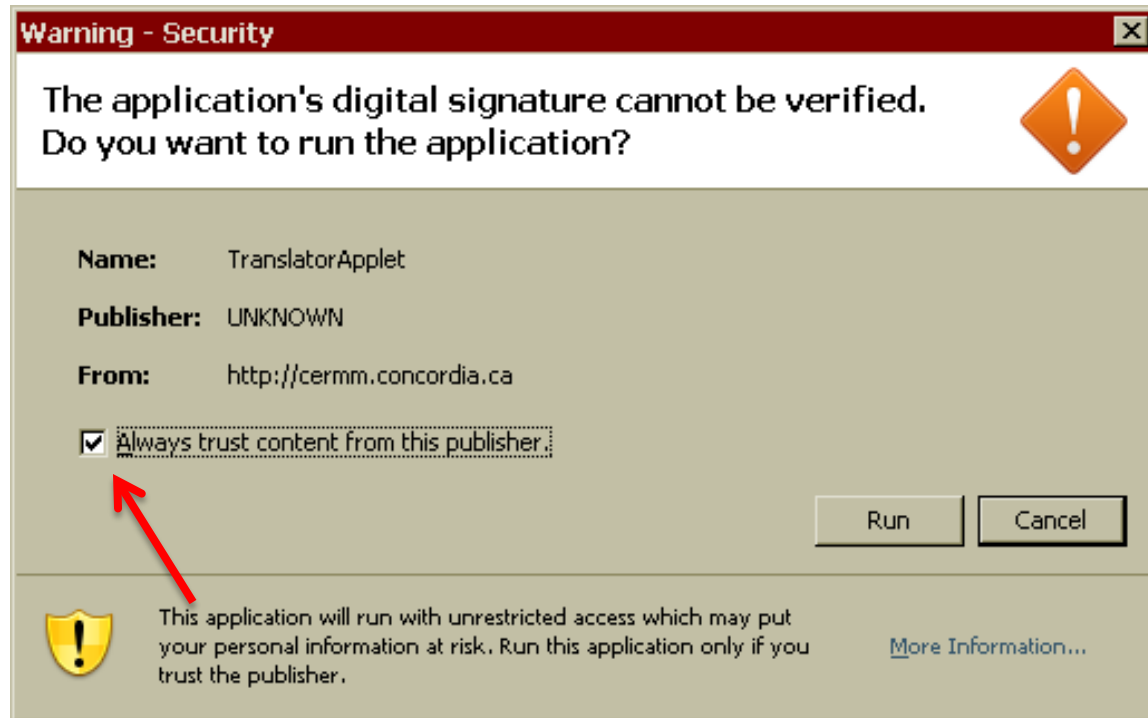
Click the *Restart Firefox* button to restart the browser



## Allow Java Quick Starter Installation

Similarly, you may also need confirm the Java Quick Starter Installation as well (Your Java Quick Starter version number may be different).

- You can always access the Firefox Add-ons Manager by opening the Firefox menu > ***Add-ons > Extensions***
- Confirm that all the ***Java add-ons*** are ***Enabled***
